## Availability

As one of the largest distributors in the industry, Ultimate Toys usually has around 60 Sprinters in production at any given time. That means immediate delivery and no wait time for our customers vs. a 4 to 5-month build time.

## #1 in Quality

Notice the quality. Our seats are built like a fine piece of furniture. Others' seats resemble those you might find in a typical RV with a kickplate that's nothing more than a piece of carpet glued to a wood frame that sticks out beyond the seat.



You'll notice our recessed kickplate not only looks better than the others', it's perfectly color-matched and designed to allow room for passengers' feet when seated. And, let's not forget about the convenient built-in drawer refrigerator (just one of two!)

## Storage Area Options

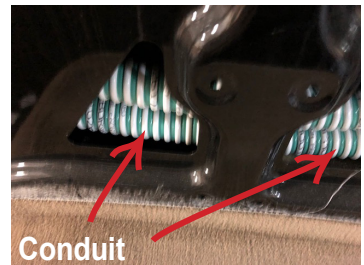
Most Sprinters have no luggage area and passengers must put their luggage on the floor at their feet or on the seats. The 144 Commuter has either 60 cu. ft. of storage space depending on which floor plan you choose. Great for luggage, golf clubs, sports equipment, kids' toys and supplies, this space can be easily accessed through the back doors or from inside while on the road.



## Attention to Details

We use up to 50% more wire fasteners and stuff our walls and ceilings full of insulation. We also utilize conduit to protect the wiring from chafing and breakage—all to ensure a quieter ride and prevent rattling and future problems down the road.

We won't mention names, but a well-known competitor uses a \$3 hinge on their cabinets while we use a \$41 hinge on ours. It's just one more example of Ultimate Toys going the extra mile to deliver the highest-quality Sprinter on the market.

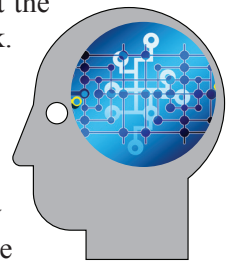

## Safety & Performance

Here's one of the best-kept secrets others won't discuss because they likely don't do it. Before we deliver our Sprinters, each one is sent back to Mercedes-Benz to have the internal computer system reprogrammed.

You see, Sprinters are originally built as cargo vans. They are very basic with no frills and are used primarily as work trucks. When it's transformed into a high-end luxury Sprinter, it becomes a completely different vehicle, but the computer's brain still thinks it is a work truck. It won't take into consideration the extra weight that's been added, changes to the suspension and other critical factors. This can dramatically affect its performance. If the "brain" isn't reprogrammed, you may experience a rougher ride, poor gas mileage and a number of other performance issues.

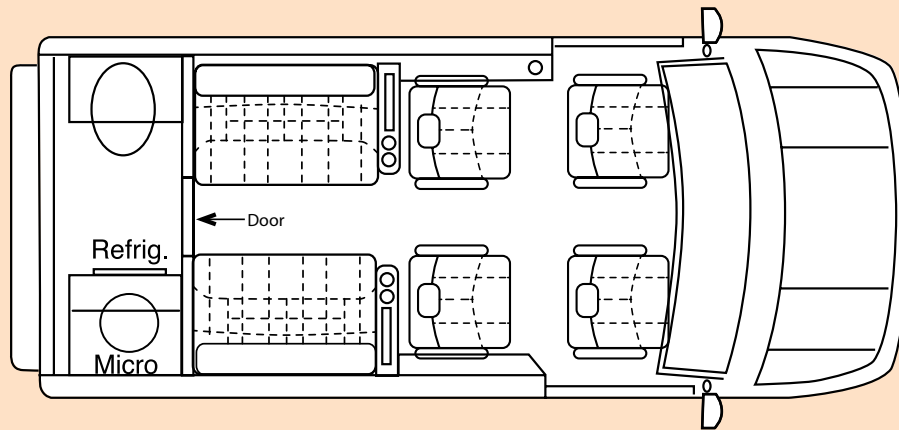

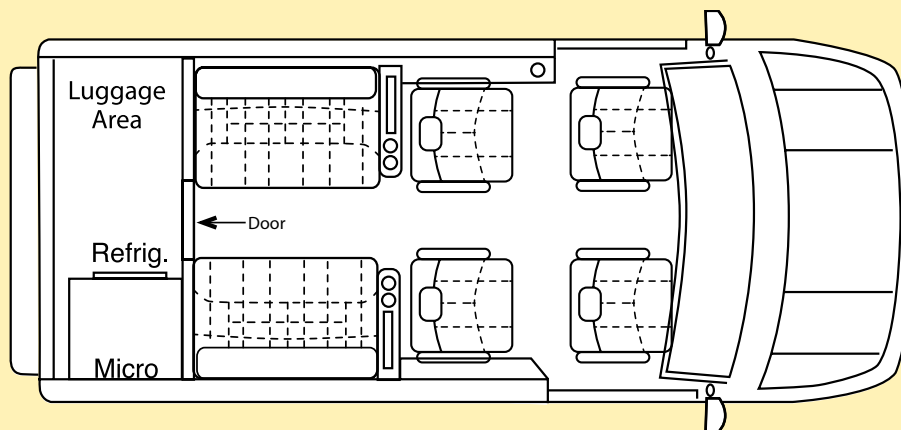
